CONSTRUCTION OF THE ST. GILES ANGLICAN PRIMARY SCHOOL
INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Government of Grenada intends to finance the construction of the St. Giles Anglican Primary School, St. Andrew. This project is geared towards enhancing the sector's ability to improve the quality of educational infrastructure, in keeping with the Government's goal of providing safe, resilient and conducive learning environment.

The Ministry of Infrastructure, Public Utilities, Civil Aviation and Transportation invites suitable Contractors to participate in this tendering process. The works include, but are not limited to the following:

1. The Construction of a two-story building that will contain eleven (11) classrooms, a library, a computer room, multi-purpose spaces and administrative accommodations.
2. External Works comprising of pavement and parking area, site drainage, perimeter fencing, road repairs and wastewater treatment facilities.
3. MEP Installation including Electrical, Plumbing and Air Conditioning

Firms whether applying individually or in the form of a Joint Venture, shall:

- a) be legally incorporated or otherwise organized in and have their principal place of business in Grenada.
- b) be more than fifty (50) percent beneficially owned dictating by a citizen or citizens and/or a bona fide resident or residents of Grenada, or by a body corporate or bodies meeting these requirements, as far as the ownership can be reasonably determined; and

The requirements for qualifications will include:

- (a) Experience as prime contractor in the construction of at least 3 assignments of similar nature and complexity comparable to the proposed project activity within the last 5 years,
- (b) An average annual construction turnover (defined as certified payments received for works in progress or completed) within the last five (5) years of at least three million dollars (XCD 3,000,000.00);
- (c) Demonstrable cash flow (including access to credit) of (EC\$) eight hundred thousand dollars (800,000.00)
- (d) Key Personnel & Equipment
- (e) Tax Compliance Certificate

(f) NIS Compliance Certificate
