REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST - FIRMS

The Government of Grenada (GOG) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) towards the cost of the Health Sector Strengthening Project and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds to eligible payments under this contract. Payment by CDB will be made only at the request of the (GOG) and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject, in all respects, to the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement. The Loan Agreement prohibits a withdrawal from the Loan Account for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import, to the knowledge of CDB, is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations. No party other than (GOG) shall derive any rights from the Loan Agreement or have any claim to the proceeds of the Loan.

The Ministry of Health is the Executing Agency of this Project and now wishes to procure consultancy services for design, design review and construction supervision of the Central Medical Stores building expansion & construction of related Flammables building at the Central medical stores.

The objectives of the consultancy are as follows;

- A. Prepare comprehensive design documentation and bidding documents to support the expansion of the Central Medical Stores (CMS) located at Mt. Rush, St. George.
- B. Conduct a design review and, where necessary, develop detailed designs and bidding documents for the associated Flammables Building, also located at Mt. Rush, St. George.
- C. Provide construction supervision services for both the Central Medical Stores and the Flammables Building.

Further details can be found in the Terms of Reference. The duration of the assignment is expected to be for a period of Eighteen (18) months. The Ministry of Health now invites interested eligible consulting firms to submit Expressions of Interest (EOI) for the provision of these consultancy services.

Consultants shall be eligible to participate if:

- (a) in the case of a body corporate, it is legally incorporated or otherwise organised in an eligible country, has its principal place of business in an eligible country and is more than 50 per cent beneficially owned by citizen(s) and/or bona fide resident(s) of eligible country(ies) or by a body(ies) corporate meeting these requirements;
- (b) in the case of unincorporated firms, the persons are citizens or bona fide residents of an eligible country; and

- (c) in all cases, the consultant has no arrangement and undertakes not to make any arrangements, whereby any substantial part of the net profits or other tangible benefits of the contract will accrue or be paid to a person not a citizen or bona fide resident of an eligible country.

Eligibility is open to all countries. countries Consultants are advised to review the detailed eligibility criteria detailed in Section 4 and conflict of interest provisions in Section 5 of the ***Procurement Procedures for Projects Financed by CDB (January, 2021), as applicable and as published on CDB's website.***

In the assessment of submissions, consideration will be given to technical competence, qualifications and experience, local and regional experience on similar assignments, financial capability, and existing commitments. Key Experts will not be evaluated at the shortlisting stage.

Interested consultant teams are required to submit their Expression of Interest using the “EOI Consulting Firms template” available on the e-procurement portal or which can be downloaded as an attachment to the REOI notice as published on the CDB website.

All information must be submitted in English. Further information may be obtained or requested through the e-procurement portal at any time before submission deadline.

Expressions of Interest must be received through the Grenada e-procurement portal only, In-Tend, at the first address below no later than September 04, 2026 AST. Submission should include the name and address of the applicant and shall be clearly marked **“Expression of Interest – design, design review and construction supervision of the Central Medical Stores building expansion & construction of related Flammables building at the Central medical stores”**.

Following the assessment of submissions, a short-list of not less than three and not more than six applicants will be provided with full terms of reference and invited to submit technical and financial proposals to undertake the assignment. (GOG) reserves the right to accept or reject late applications or to cancel the present invitation partially or in its entirety. It will not be bound to assign any reason for not selecting any applicant and will not defray any costs incurred by any applicant in the preparation and submission of Expressions of Interest.
